Tuition fees are revised annually. The increase is normally between 2% and 7% and is applied annually to each year of the programme, including for continuing students.

Tuition fees for UK undergraduate students on the BMus programme are aligned with the maximum tuition fee cap set by the UK government.

Figures in brackets are the fees for students already studying in the 23/24 academic year continuing on the same programme in 24/25.
